



## Alceno Tinto

### **Red Wine**

### **Vintage:**

2009

### **Characteristics of vineyards:**

Selected from our oldest vineyards coming from calcareous soil, located between 600-800 meters above sea level, with yields that do not surpass 1.5kg. per plant.

### **Grape Variety:**

55% Monastrell, 30% Syrah, 15% Tempranillo

**Alcohol 20°C:** 13.72 % Vol.

**Total Acidity:** 5.30 gr. / lt.

**Sugar Reductor:** 4.0 gr. / l.

**Total SO<sub>2</sub>:** 35 mg. / l.

### **Notes:**

Young, elaborated with Monastrell, Tempranillo and Syrah in such a way that the fruity flavor of the grape is kept transmitted to the wine.

The result is a wine with an intense purple red color and a violet edge, with an intense fruit-bearing aroma evoking touches of ripe fruits. On the palate, this wine feels intense, long with well-balanced acidity, very fruity and sweet. The balance between palate and nose is extremely harmonious.
