#### Description

The wines of the Serein left bank are flinty with the mineral aromas of typical Chablis. To reveal the typical minerality of this soil, Jean- Marc Brocard has selected the best Premiers Crus of the left bank of the river Serein : Montmains et Vau de Vey.

**2008 vintage :** *Pure minerality with notes of chalk.*

**Vinification :** *Pneumatic pressing. Stainless steel fermentation with temperature control.*

**Malolactic fermentation** completed.

(a "left bank" wine) Pale yellow. Deeply pitched aromas of apple and flinty minerality. Juicy but subdued, even tight, with brisk but ripe acidity and plenty of CO2 keeping the fruit and mineral flavors under wraps. But this boasts good density and a distinct impression of sucrosite, finishing quite tactile, with a musky gingery quality. **88-90 points**
